If you are raising a relative's child, you may be eligible for assistance.

The **Kinship Caregiver Support Program** offers financial assistance for those raising a relative's a child, age 18 or younger. Funds can be used to help pay for emergent needs such as utility or rent hardships, car repairs, child medications, tutoring, food and other expenses.
