



Did you know... The Parents Who Host, Lose The Most?

In a recent national survey of parents and teens by the National Center on Addiction and Substance Abuse at Columbia University, **one-third of teens have been to parties where teens were drinking alcohol, smoking pot, or using cocaine, Ecstasy or prescription drugs while a parent was present. By age 17, nearly half (46 percent) of teens have been at such parties where parents were present.**

Adults who knowingly allow a person under age 21 to remain on their property while consuming or possessing alcoholic beverages can be prosecuted and face jail sentencing, fines, civil lawsuits and/or loss of property.



Parents play a major role in their children's choices about alcohol, tobacco or other drugs. Research shows that most teenagers appreciate it when their parents set boundaries and establish expectations that are fairly enforced.
