Washington State has strict "Social Host" laws?

A "social host" is anyone who hosts or allows a party, a gathering or an event where minors are consuming alcoholic beverages. As celebrations and summer activities begin, don't forget your role...

- It is illegal to give alcohol to your child's friends who are under 21.
- It is illegal to permit minors to consume alcohol on property that you own, which includes your boat, motor home, undeveloped property, cabin, automobile, rental property, or house.
- Parents can be arrested and criminally charged for providing a place for minors to consume alcohol.

Parental disapproval of underage drinking is the key reason youth have chosen not to drink, your example impacts your child's choices.
